Home Rule allows citizens to manage their own governmental affairs. By means of voting, they can show approval or disapproval of their government and insist that it properly represents the people.

Included in this collection are reports and information on the various committees within the Weld County Home Rule, which are Health, Personnel, Administration, & Finance & Taxation. The County Service Reports file contains information on elections, recording, Vehicle Registration, & Attorneys, while the file on county relations deals with Local Improvement districts & the Regional Council of Governments. 1975 Charter Drafts show the process by which voters can make changes in the charter. Also contained in this collection are notes, pamphlets, clippings & booklets, for the information of the public, & finally, a final 1973 copy of the Home Rule Charter.
