### **Abstract:**

This collection consists primarily of items pertaining to the history of the University of Northern Colorado and consists of photographs, negatives, clippings and other printed items, correspondence, a list of University of Northern Colorado history students who received Hazel E. Johnson Awards, Alpharetta Lemmon items, commercially taken photographs of Europe circa 1900, and Cranford Hall slide show with a script.

### **Scope and Content Note:**

This collection consists primarily of items pertaining to the history of the University of Northern Colorado and consists of photographs, negatives, clippings and other printed items, correspondence, a list of University of Northern Colorado history students who received Hazel E. Johnson Awards, Alpharetta Lemmon items, commercially taken photographs of Europe circa 1900, and Cranford Hall slide show with a script.

### **Historical Note:**

This is a collection of materials given by Hazel E. Johnson of Greeley to the University on the occasion of its Centennial in 1989. Ms. Johnson has lived in Greeley since 1938 when she first came here as a member of the staff of the Colorado State Revenue Department. She had gathered photographs, clippings and other items about the college since her arrival here.

On April 14, 1989, at the beginning of the Centennial celebration, the Library, together with other sponsors, held a Hazel Johnson Day reception. Information about the day is included in the file.

Ms. Johnson stipulated that her gift be maintained as a single collection in her name, and gave the materials to the Archives outright. A document to that effect is in the file. (Series 7).

### **Biography of Hazel E. Johnson:**

Miss Hazel E. Johnson was born August 30, 1902, to Benjamin and Cora Belle (Jeet) Johnson in Leon, [Oklahoma?]. Her family moved to Fountain, Colorado in 1918. After graduating from Fountain High School, she attended Blair's Business College in Colorado Springs, Colorado. She worked at the First National Bank in Fountain and for the clerk in Springfield, Colorado. She came to Greeley in 1938 as an employee of the Colorado State Revenue Department. Hazel E. Johnson was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Greeley.<sup>1</sup>

Hazel E. Johnson wrote over “1,000 newspaper columns about Greeley and Weld County history.”<sup>2</sup> She wrote an “Out of the Past” column in *The Greeley Journal* for twenty years and contributed articles to the *Christian Science Monitor* and *Senior Voice*. In addition, she gave numerous presentations to local clubs and organizations.
