8 or More	<i>Same as above (first author, et al., and year).</i> Rietschel et al. (1994)	<i>Cite the first author every time followed by et al.</i>	<i>Include the names of the first six authors, an ellipsis (...), and the last author’s name:</i> Rietschel, E. T., Kirikae, T., Schade, F. U., Mamat, U., Schmidt, G., Loppnow, H., ... Padova, F. (1994).
Group Authors: Corporate Government Organization	In the 2007 annual report of General Motors... OR The National Institutes of Health (2007) reported... OR The organization reported... (American Red Cross, 2007).	<i>Cite as before, unless the group is easily recognized by an acronym.</i> <i>If this is true, see pp.176-177 of the APA Publication Manual for instructions.</i>	General Motors. Author Problems	Text Citation	Reference Citation
I have a resource with two authors with the same last name, but different first names.	<i>Include the authors’ first names in a parenthetical citation:</i> (Smith Thomas, 1968) (Smith Travis, 1986)	<i>Include the authors’ first names in brackets after their surname and first initial:</i> Smith, T. [Thomas]. (1968). Smith, T. [Travis]. (1986).
I have ordered my references alphabetically, but I have several sources by the same author.	<i>Use the name(s) and corresponding year from the reference citation.</i> (Cruise, 1986). (Cruise, Holmes & Cruise, 2006). (Cruise & Kidman, 1990). (Cruise & Rogers, 1987).	<i>Order sources alphabetically using additional authors. If there is only one author or there are authors who wrote together multiple times, use the year as your secondary ordering system:</i> Cruise, T. (1986). Cruise, T., Holmes, K., & Cruise, S. (2006). Cruise, T. & Kidman, N. (1990). Cruise, T. & Rogers, M. (1987).

I have two sources by the same author that he published in the same year.	<p><i>Use the name(s) and corresponding year from the reference citation.</i></p> <p>(Cruise, 1983a). (Cruise, 1983b). (Cruise, 1983c).</p>	<p><i>When two or more sources by the same author (or more authors with authors all in the same order) are published in the same year, order the references by title, and then add a lowercase letter immediately after the date:</i></p> <p>Cruise, T. (1983a). <i>All the right moves</i>. Cruise, T. (1983b). <i>The outsiders</i>. Cruise, T. (1983c). <i>Risky business</i>.</p> <p>Please note that the above example is <i>NOT</i> how you would cite a movie; movie citations use the producer and director in place of an author, not the principal actor.</p>
My resource has no author.	<p><i>Use the first few words of the title in place of the author:</i> (Police lose eight, 2009)</p> <p><i>Only when a work is signed with Anonymous do you use the word anonymous as the author:</i> (Anonymous, 1772).</p>	<p><i>Move the title of a work to where the author usually goes (before the date of publication).</i> Police lose eight sex offenders. (2009).</p> <p><i>Only when a work is signed with Anonymous do you use the word anonymous as the author:</i> Anonymous. (1772).</p>
